

# The Superintendent's Cup

The Superintendent's Cup is an annual challenge activity program sponsored by the Frederick County Association of Student Councils (FCASC). Participation in the program is open to all secondary schools in FCPS. Each year FCASC will designate the local service project/group who will be the beneficiary of the program. Schools compete in the challenge by forming teams to participate in the focus activity and earn points based on their participation. Monthly challenges, individual and school participation, and total efforts will be monitored and tallied throughout the designated time frame. The school with the most points will be designated as the "Superintendent's Cup Winner".

## Program Goals:

- to increase school participation and student participation in local service activities,
- to foster school based student leadership, and
- to engage students in their communities.



## 2018 Superintendent's Cup Beneficiary → Walk to Cure Arthritis

The Arthritis foundation's Walk to cure Arthritis is a walk event to raise funds to fight arthritis. It will take place in March which is National Arthritis Month. Teams are formed with friends, families and more to accomplish two goals; to raise money and participate in the event. Money raised will be used towards, finding a cure, advocating for arthritis ( lower cost treatments and more specialists), helping educate others and helping families who have members that have arthritis. This is the ONE event when we can come together, meet new faces in the community, celebrate Arthritis warriors, and be apart of one big team.

## Awards:

A Superintendent's Cup Winner banner to display and keep at your school.

The Superintendent's Cup Traveling Trophy engraved with your school name to display for one year.

**Point System\*:** General Participation:

- 500 points for creating a school team

- 50 points for each student registered from your school

- 25 points per hour for each team member at the event

General

Fundraising:

- 1 point for every dollar raised by your school

- 100 bonus points for each \$500 your team raises

## **December:**

Challenge: Register your team online with captains designated

Points: 500 for every time registered and 50 points for that team per person that registers for that team

## **January:**

Challenge: Create posters and social media posts to spread awareness about Arthritis.

Points: 5 points for every post and poster created

A form will be submitted to each schools SGA advisor to record points

## **FEBRUARY:**

Challenge: Do-it-Yourself Fundraiser Project for Walk to Cure

- Each team will submit a fundraising plan to raise money towards the foundation

A form will be submitted to each schools SGA advisor to record points

Points:

100 points for every plan submitted and 100 points (bonus) for every time who actually raises money with that plan
